## „Baruka" bracelet



Material for one component (you will need 4-5 components for one bracelet):
Matubo Rulla: 10 pcs
Matubo Superduo in two colors: SD1-8 pcs, SD2-8 pcs
Matubo 11/0: 12 pcs (you can also use Japanese round 11/0s or 11/0 Delicas)
Matubo 8/0: 4 pcs
15/0 japanese seed beads: 12 pcs
Beading needle and thread
Jump rings (outer diameter 5 mm and wire gauge 22-23 work best), a clasp, optionally eyepins and $5-6 \mathrm{~mm}$ round beads for embellishment.

## Difficulty: For beginners/intermediate



1. String three Rullas, one SD1, three SD2, one SD1, three Rullas, one SD1, three SD2, one SD1.

2. Slide all the beads to the end of the thread and tie a square knot to form a circle. Then align the beads to get the same shape as in the photo - all the beads should face "outwards", except for the middle SD2 on each side - these should face "inwards".

3. Pass through the upper hole of the nearest Rulla.
4. Add one 11/0 ...

5. ... and pass through the upper hole of the next Rulla.

6. Add one SD1 ...
7. ... and pass through the upper hole of the next SD2
8. ... skip the inwardfacing SD2 and pass through the upper hole of the next SD2.
9. Add one SD1 and pass through the upper hole of the next SD1.

10. Add one $11 / 0$...
11. ... and pass through the upper hole of the next Rulla.
12. Add one $11 / 0$ and pass through the upper hole of the next Rulla.

13. Add one $11 / 0$ and pass through the upper hole of the next Rulla.
14. Add one 11/0 ...

15. ... and pass through the upper hole of the next SD1.

16. Add one SD1 and pass through the upper hole of the next SD1.

17. Add one $11 / 0$ and then pass through the upper hole of the next Rulla...

18. ... upper hole of the next Rulla and another 11/0 ...

19. ... two SD1s (as shown in the photo)...

20. ... two SD2s (as shown in the photo) ...

21. ... one SD2 and the next SD1.

22. Make the step-up by passing back through the upper hole of the last SD1.

23. Add one Rulla and one $15 / 0$ and pass through the upper hole of the "middle" SD2.

24. Pull snug.

25. Add one $15 / 0$ and one Rulla and pass through the upper hole of the next SD1.

26. Pull snug.

27. Then pass back through the other hole of the same SD2 and through the upper hole of the next SD2 ...

28. ... and through the next two SD1s (as shown in the photo. .

29. Then pass through the next 11/0, Rulla, 11/0 ...
30. ... next Rulla, 11/0, the last Rulla and another 11/0 ...

31. ... and two SD1s (as shown in the photo) ...

32. ... and two SD2s (as shown in the photo) ...
33. ... and the next SD2 and another SD1.

34. Then pass back through the upper hole of the same SD1.
35. add one Rulla and one 15/0.

36. Pass through the "middle" SD2.

37. Add one $15 / 0$ and one Rulla and pass through the next SD1.

38. Pass back through the other hole of the same SD1 the thread is exiting from and through the next two SD2s (as shown in the photo).
39. Pass back through the other hole of the last SD2 and also through the next $15 / 0$ and the lower hole of the next Rulla.

40. Pass back through the other hole of the same Rulla.

41. Add one $11 / 0$, one $8 / 0$ and one $11 / 0$ and pass through the upper hole of the next Rulla.

42. Pass back throught the other hole of the same Rulla and also through the next 15/0 and through the upper hole of the next SD2.

43. Then pass back through the other hole of the same SD2 and through the upper hole of the next SD2 ...

44. Then pass back through the other hole of the same SD2 and through the upper hole of the next SD2 ...

45. And then pass back through the other hole of the same SD2.

46. Add one $15 / 0$, one $11 / 0$, one $8 / 0$, one $11 / 0$ and one $15 / 0$ and then pass through the "free" hole of the SD2 on the other side (a shown in the photo).

47. Pass back through the upper hole of the same SD2 and then through the lower hole of the next SD2.

48. Now pass through the lower hole of the next
SD1 ...

49. ... and through the next three Rullas.

50. Now the thread exits from the same spot where the starting knot is. So now you can tie both ends of the thread together and then cut them off.

51. ... and through the next SD2.

52. Use jump rings to connect all the components together and attach the clasp.
