

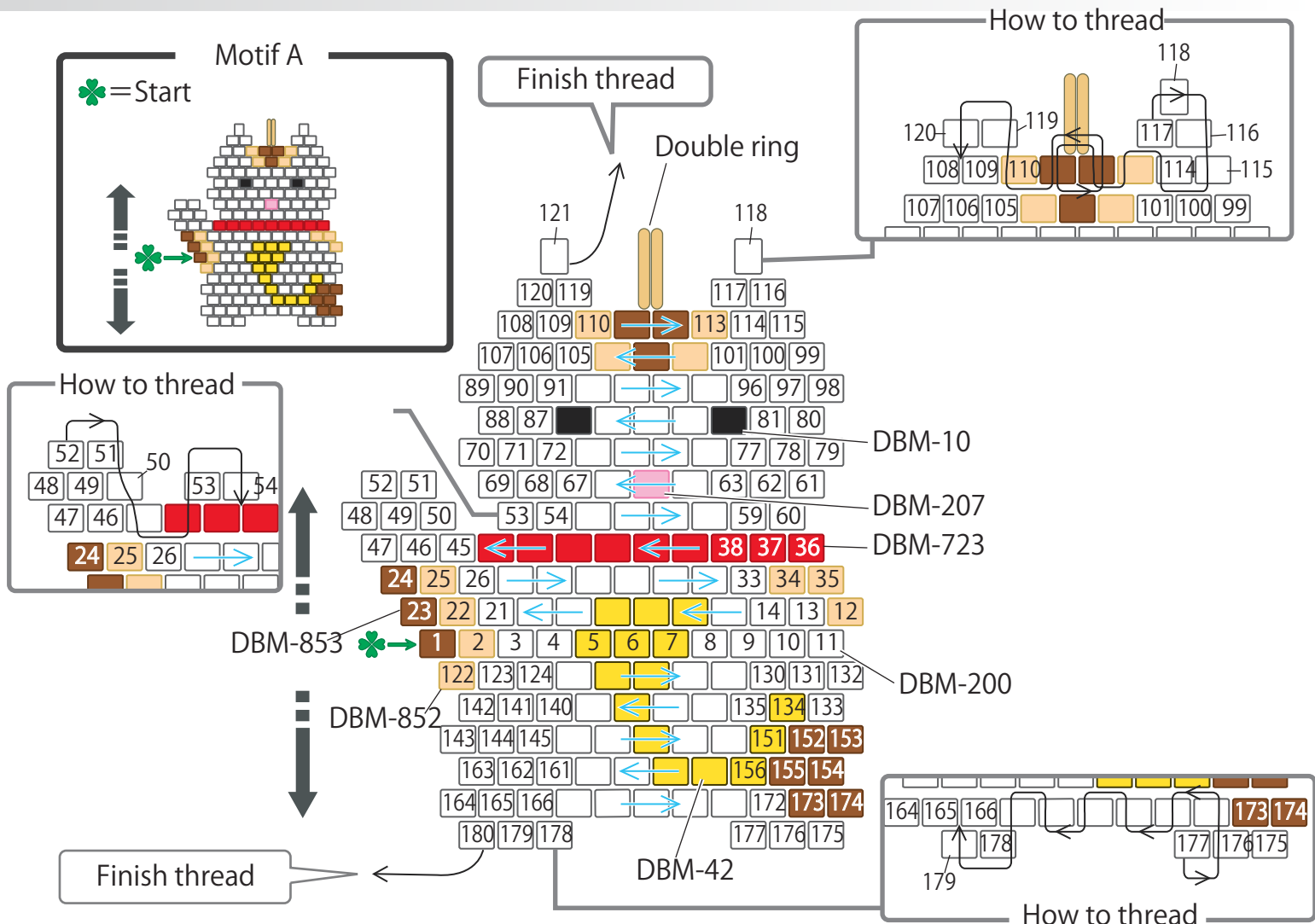

*Tools: Scissors, Ruler, Pliers, and Beading Needles

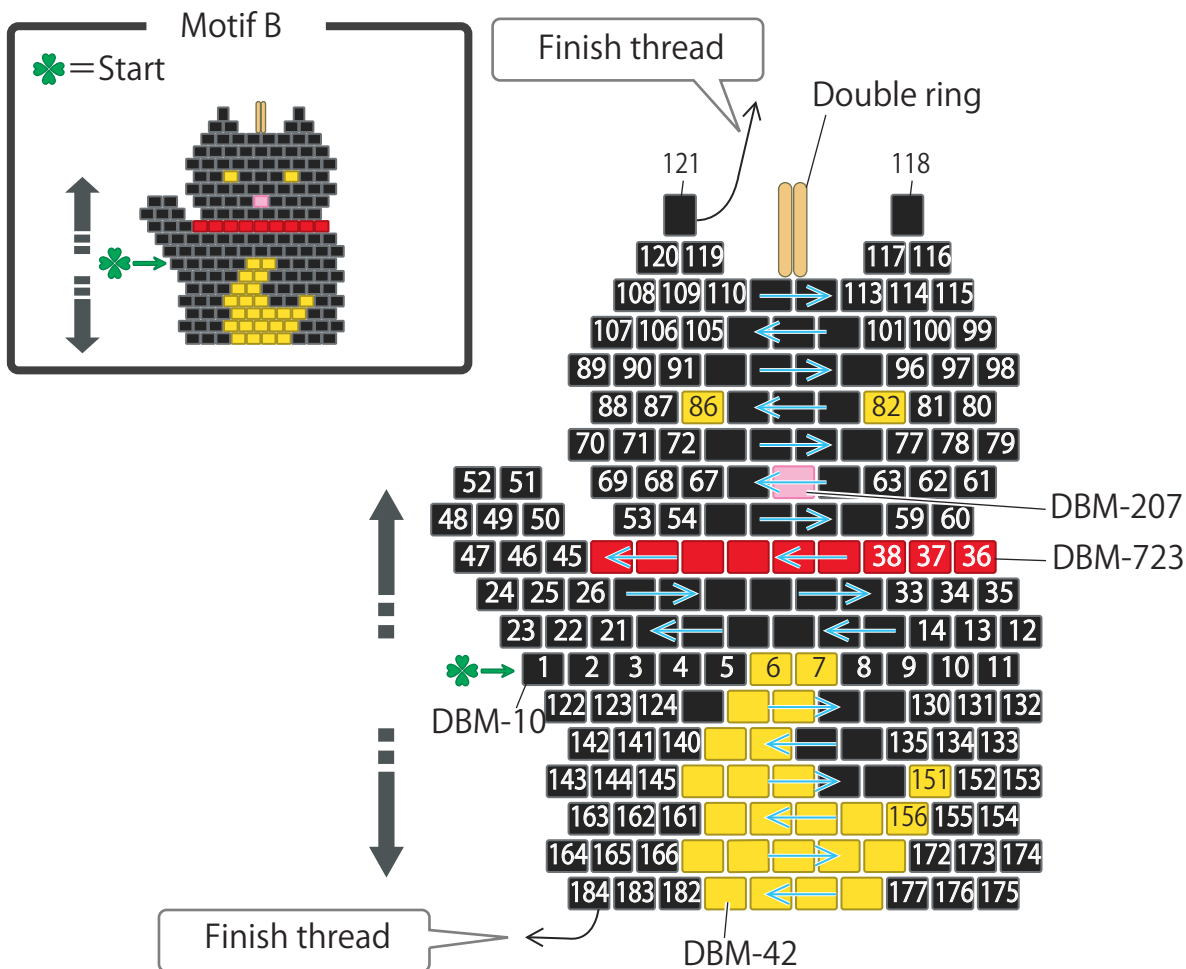
Materials

| Delica Beads size 10 | Tonbo-dama 6mm : 2 pcs (Yellow x 1, Pink x 1) |
| DBM10 : 150 pcs | Nylon thread /White |
| DBM42 : 41 pcs | Double rings /Gold : 2 pcs |
| DBM200 : 130 pcs | Pearl beads 4mm /Matte Gold : 4 pcs |
| DBM207 : 2 pcs | Ball Chains 1.6x100mm/ Gold : 2 pcs |
| DBM723 : 18 pcs | Eye pins 0.7x15mm/ Gold : 6 pcs |
| DBM852 : 11 pcs | Jump rings 6mm/ Gold : 4 pcs |
| DBM853 : 12 pcs | Koban charm 9x19mm/ Gold : 2 pcs |

Use 1.3m of nylon thread, thread a needle. Leave 50cm thread tail and string a stopper bead. String Deica Beads and then start weaving Delica Beads of the ladder stitching part (1 - 11) and brick stitching part (12-121) by using the 80cm thread. While stitching (110 - 113), add a double ring and after you complete stitching (12-121), finish the thread tails. Remove the stopper bead and stitch thae part (122-180) by using the 50cm thread tail. Finish the thread tail.



2) Use 1.3m of nylon thread, thread a needle. Leave 50cm thread tail and string a stopper bead. Make Motif B under the same process as (1).



3) Put an eye pin through a pearl bead hole, curve the eye pin. Make 4 pcs of this (Part ① : see below picture). Make Part ② (see below picture) with Tonbo-dama and an eye pin. Connect Part A with Part B, ball chain, jump rings, Koban-charm and each Maneki-Neko motif.
