Material (length without clasp 15,5 cm)


8 pcs **Fixer V**
30 pcs **Ginko**
15 pcs **Fire polished beads 3 mm**
16 pcs **Matubo 8/0**
60 pcs **Toho Demi Round 8/0**
98 pcs **Toho 11/0**
8 pcs **Toho 15/0**

2 pcs **jump rings**
clasp

beading needle (size 10 or 12)
beading thread (S-Lon, Nymo...)

Difficulty: for beginners and intermediate

thread, direction of weaving knot (end of weaving)



1) String T11/0, M8/0, T11/0, Ginko (from inside), T11/0, TDR, FP, TDR, T11/0.



2) Go back through the free hole of the Ginko (from outside) and then add T11/0, M8/0, T11/0 and one Ginko (from inside).



3) String T11/0, 4x T15/0 and T11/0 and pass back through the free hole of the Ginko (from outside).



4) Tie the beads together with a double knot.



5) Pass through T11/0, M8/0, T11/0, Ginko, T11/0, TDR and FP.



6) Add TDR, T11/0, Ginko (from outside), T11/0, M8/0, T11/0, Ginko (from inside), T11/0, TDR, FP, TDR and T11/0.



7) Pass through the free hole of the Ginko (from outside).



8) Add T11/0, M8/0, T11/0 and pass through the free hole of the Ginko (from inside).



9) Add T11/0 and TDR and go through FP.




10) Go through the following beads, as shown. Repeat steps 6) - 10) five times.



11) String the last part TDR, T11/0, Ginko (from outside), T11/0, M8/0, T11/0, Ginko (from inside) - add T11/0, 4x T15/0, T11/0 to the end of the bracelet.




12) Go back through the free hole of the Ginko (from outside), add T11/0, M8/0, T11/0 and go through the free hole of the next Ginko (from inside).




13) Add T11/0, TDR and go through FP and the next beads, as shown.




14) Thread one Fixer (from inside) as shown and add T11/0, TDR, FP, TDR and T11/0.



15) Pay attention to the correct sewing direction through the Fixer!




16) Pass the Fixer through the hole in the opposite (diagonal) corner (from outside).




17) Pass through T11/0, M8/0, T11/0 between the two Ginkos on the opposite side.



18) Tighten and place the Fixer over both Ginkos.




19) Go through the Fixer from inside through the nearest hole, add T11/0 and TDR and go through FP.



20) Pay attention to the correct sewing direction through FP!



21) Add TDR and T11/0.



22) Go through the last free hole of the Fixer (from outside), T11/0, M8/0, T11/0 and next Ginko (from inside).



23) Pass through the beads, as shown.



24) Reapeat steps 14) - 23) until you complete the row. Finish with the double knot and stitch.



25) Different types of clasps.



26) Add jump rings to attach the clasp.
