
What materials do you need?

Ca. 5 gr.	(15/0) 15/0 Seed Beads	15-92001 Matte Blue Grey	15-91310 Transparent Dyed Fuchsia
Ca. 3 gr.	(HJ) Honeycomb Bead® Jewels	HCJ0623980-14400 Gunmetal	HCJ0623980-14415 Bronze
Ca. 8 gr.	(AP) Arcos® Par Puca®	ARC510-00030-27000 Argentees/Crystal Labrador Full	ARC510-00030-27000 Argentees/Crystal Labrador Full
Ca. 55 pcs.	1 Clasp of choice	Silver	Silver
Ca. 40 pcs.	5 mm Jumprings (if these are not included with the clasp)	Silver	Silver
Scissors	Chain nose pliers	Size 12 Needle	S-Lon D or similar

INFORMATION

If you don't have Honeycomb Jewels you can also use regular Honeycomb Beads.

TIP: Keep your end thread for some of the last steps!



Step 1A - Figure 1

Pick up 1 x AP (through the left hole, from top to bottom) - 1 x 15/0 - 1 x HJ (through the left hole) - 1 x 15/0 - 1 x AP (through the right hole, from bottom to top).


Leave about 8 inches of end thread.

Step 1B - Figure 2

Pick up 1 x 15/0, go through the second (right) hole of the HJ you strung in step 1A. Pick up 1 x 15/0, go through the most right hole of the AP.

Step 2A - Figure 3

Pick up 1 x 11/0 - 15/0 - 11/0 - AP (left hole, from top to bottom) - 15/0 - HJ (left hole) - 15/0 - AP (left hole, from bottom to top).



Step 2B - Figure 3

Pick up 1 x 11/0 - 15/0 - 11/0, go through the first hole of the AP that sits on the left side, go through the 15/0 - HJ - 15/0 - AP, the 11/0 - 15/0 - 11/0 - AP - 15/0 - HJ - 15/0 - AP, then go through the most right hole of the AP you're exiting from.

Step 2C - Figure 4

Repeat step 1B





Step 3 - Figure 5

Repeat steps 2A, 2B and 2C for the rest of the bracelet. Please keep in mind that the clasp will add length to your bracelet.

When you have reached the desired length, exit with your thread from the right (upper) hole of the last AP you strung.

Step 4A - Figure 6

Pick up 1 x 15/0, go back through the same bead (hole) you're exiting from, the 15/0, HJ, 15/0, AP (right bottom hole).



Step 4B - Figure 7

Repeat step 4A for the bottom of the AP you're now exiting from.

Step 4C - Figure 8 + 9

Switch your needle to your end thread! Repeat 4A and 4B for the other side of your bracelet. Switch your needle back. Come out of the first 15/0 you strung in step 4A (figure 7).






Step 5 - Figure 10

Pick up $15 \times 15/0$, go through the next 15/0 of step 4B.

Tip: This will be the loop for your clasp! If you have a clasp with attached jumprings, please string it along in this step! If not, bead further ☺



Step 6A - Figure 11

Pick up 7 x 15/0, go through the 11/0, 15/0, 11/0.

Step 6B - Figure 11

Repeat step 6A until you have reached the other 15/0 you strung in step 4B on the other side of the bracelet.

Step 6C - Figure 11

Repeat step 5.

Step 6D - Figure 11

Repeat step 6A. Go through all the beads again for added strength. When you have finished, weave back and forth to secure your thread and tie it off.




Step 7 - Figure 12

Last but not least, add your clasp if you haven't done it already in step 5!
