To start this piece you will need to create a foundation using Ladder Stitch. This is shown on the graph and word chart.

The foundation (starting row) in this design is Row 18, start this row in the middle of your thread, this way you can use the thread on each side of the foundation row to complete the design using decreasing brick stitch.

Rows 1-17 are for the top half of the earring, before finishing your thread at the top you will need to sew in the Wire Guard

Rows 19-34 are for the bottom half of the earring.

The loop at the back of the earring has a split in the middle which you can twist open to attach to the wire guard.

Stitches Used

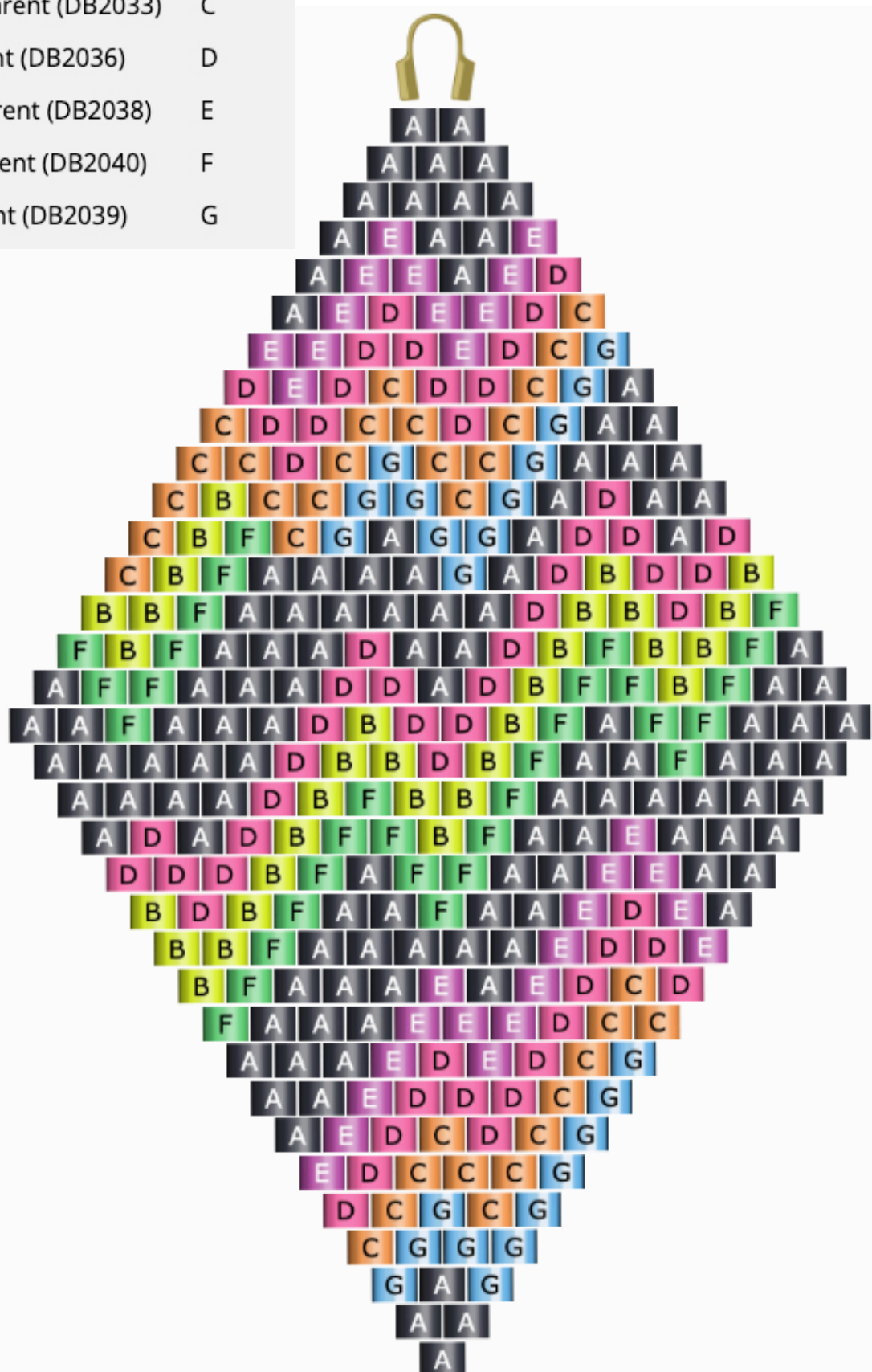
Brick Stitch - an off loom bead weaving technique where beads are stacked horizontally like bricks in a wall. This stitch has roots in Native American and other cultures, with its origins difficult to pinpoint. It is known for its strength and versatility in creating detailed, durable beadwork

Ladder - an off loom bead technique it often forms the foundation of more advanced bead stitches, such as herringbone and brick stitch.
