Materials

Size 8/0 Seed Beads – Three Colours

Beading Thread .006

Size #10 Beading Needle

2 x 6mm Jump Rings

1 Pair Ear Wires

Scissors / Thread Zapper

Chain Nose Pliers

Beading Mat

Beginner Beadweaving

One Hour or Less

Abbreviations used for colours in sample picture

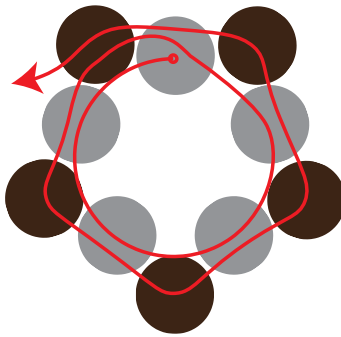
S8A –Color A Size 8/0Seed Bead – Silver

S8B –Color B Size 8/0Seed Bead – Root Beer

S8C –Color C Size 8/0Seed Bead – Matte Copper

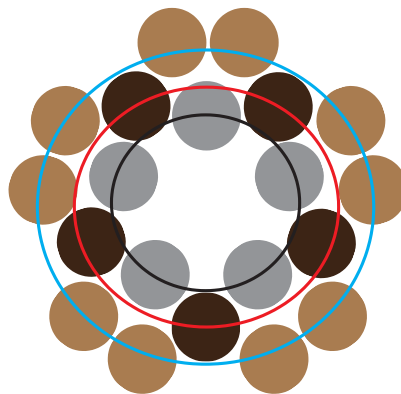
Step 1

Cut approximately 30" of beading thread. Leave a 7" tail. String (5) S8A. Go back through all the beads and the first bead once more. [String (1) S8B and go through the next S8A] five times. Step up through the first S8B.



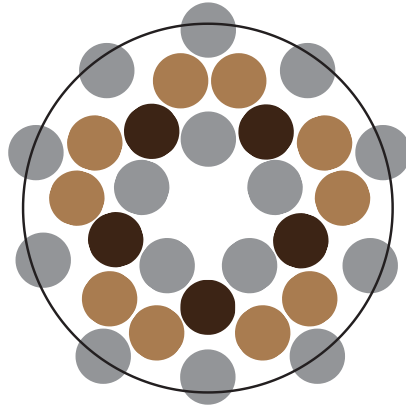
Step 2

[String (2) S8C. Go through the next S8B] five times. Step up through the first S8C.



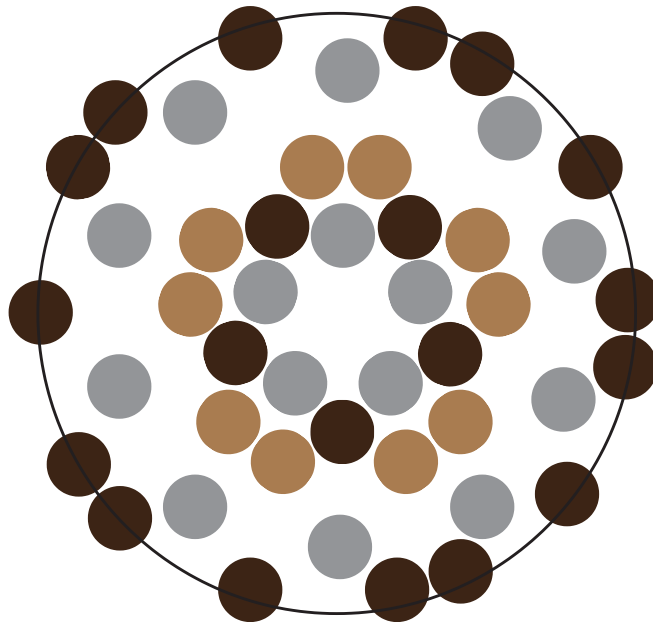
Step 3

[String (1)S8A.Go through the next S8C] ten times. Step up through the first S8A added in this round.



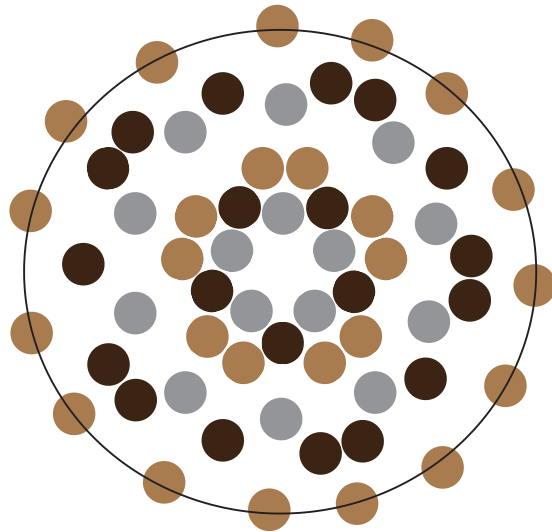
Step 4

[String (2)S8B. Go through the next S8A. String (1)S8B.Go through the next S8A] five times. Step up through the first S8B.



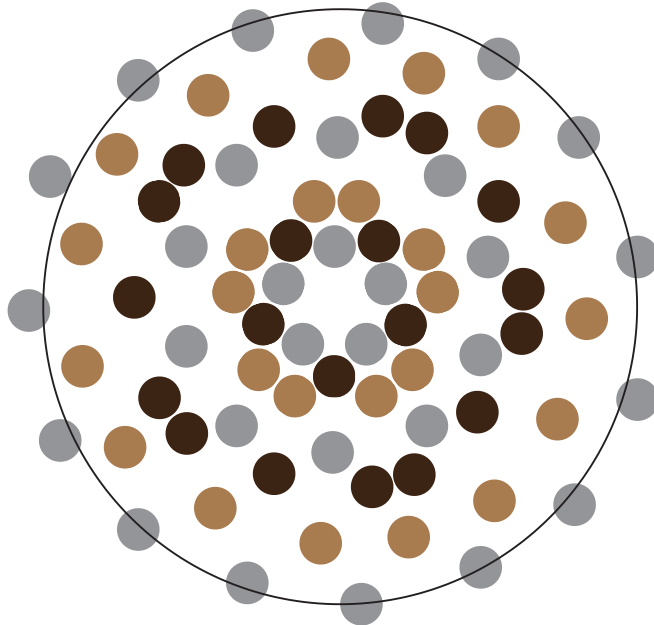
Step 5

[String (1)S8C.Go through the next S8B] fifteen times. Step up through the first S8C.



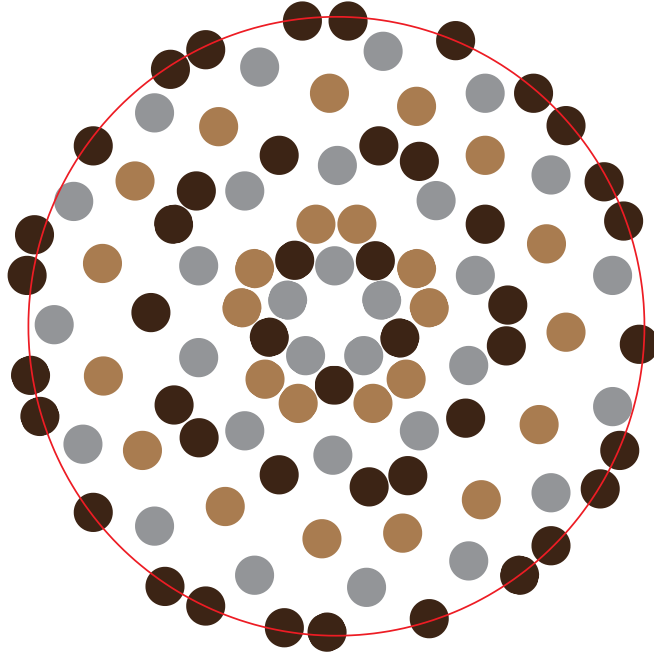
Step 6

[String (1)S8A.Go through the next S8C] fifteen times. Step up through the first S8A.



Step 7

[[String (2)S8B. Go through the next S8A] twice. String (1)S8B. Go through the next S8A] five times. Step up through the first S8B.



Step 8

Weave to exit from in between the next, two S8B. String (1)S8B. Go through the next S8B. Weave in remaining working and tail thread and trim. Attach a jumpring with ear wire to the top S8B.
