298 x Miyuki 11/0 Delica - (F)
2 x 15.6mm x 4.8mm Black Plated 304 Stainless Steel Spacer Beads
1 x 15.6mm x 29mm Black Plated 304 Stainless Steel Glue in Magnet
25cm 12mm x 6mm Braided Leather

Tools & Other Required Items

Beading Needle - Size 10 or 12
Thread - Fireline 6lb / S-Lon Fire 4lb / Miyuki or KO
Scissors
Thread Burner
E6000 Glue

Design and bead count above are for all three of the bead tubes shown in the photo on page 1.

You will need to adjust the length of the leather cut based on your wrist size, we advise having all of the beads on the leather when testing the length.

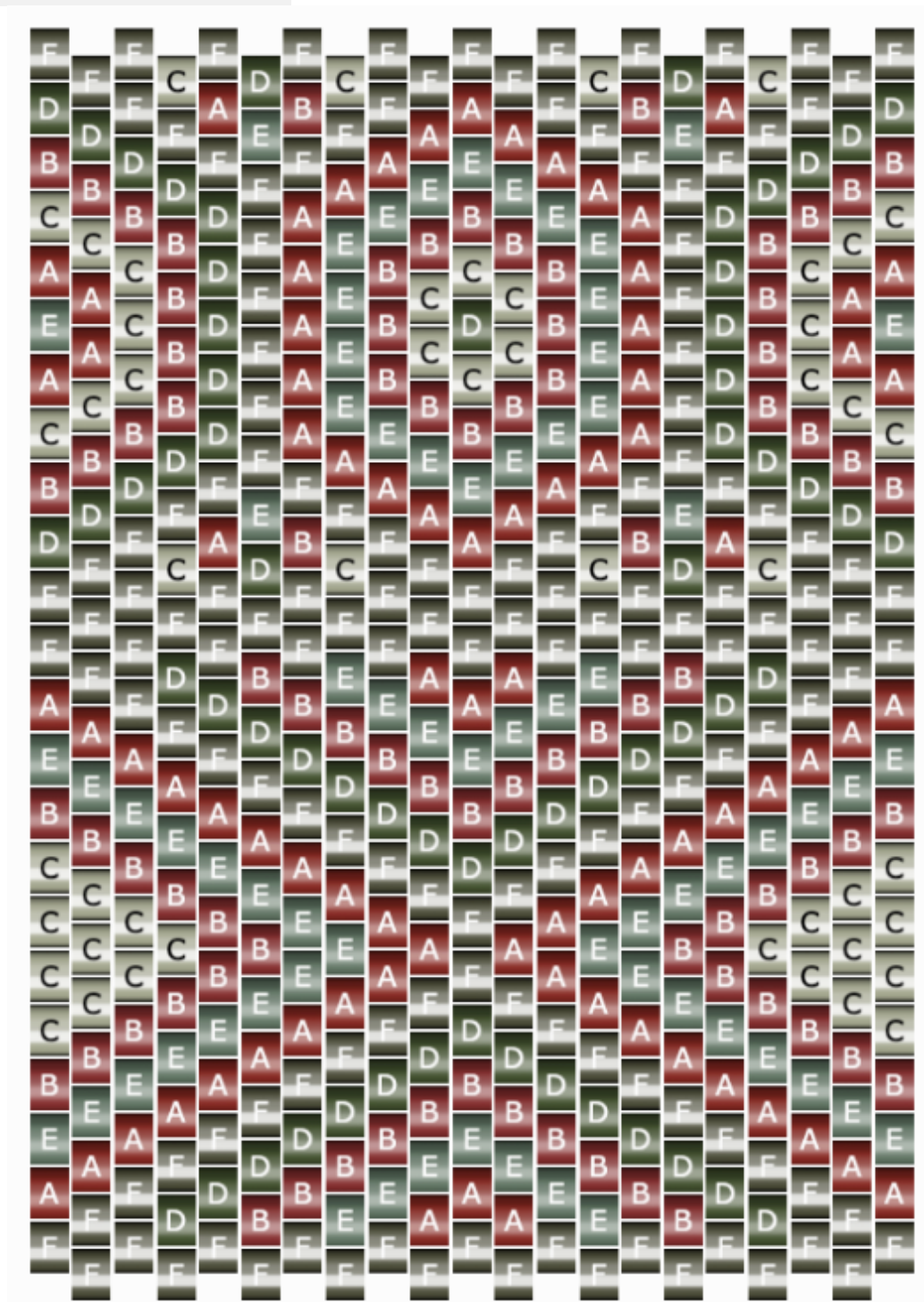
The videos show two different approaches to odd count peyote and assembling the bracelet.

Stitches Used

Peyote - an off-loom beading technique, it can be worked with either an even or odd number of beads per row.

Instructions - Peyote Centre Flat Tube

Rows 1 and 2: → 3F, 1C, 1F, 1D, 1F, 1C, 5F, 1C, 1F, 1D, 1F, 1C, 3F

Row 3: ← 1D, 1F, 1A, 1B, 1F, 1A, 1F, 1B, 1A, 1F, 1D

Row 4: → 1D, 1F, 1E, 1F, 2A, 1F, 1E, 1F, 1D

Row 5: ← 1B, 1D, 2F, 1A, 1E, 1A, 2F, 1D, 1B

Row 6: → 1B, 1D, 1F, 1A, 2E, 1A, 1F, 1D, 1B

Row 7: ← 1C, 1B, 1D, 1A, 1E, 1B, 1E, 1A, 1D, 1B, 1C

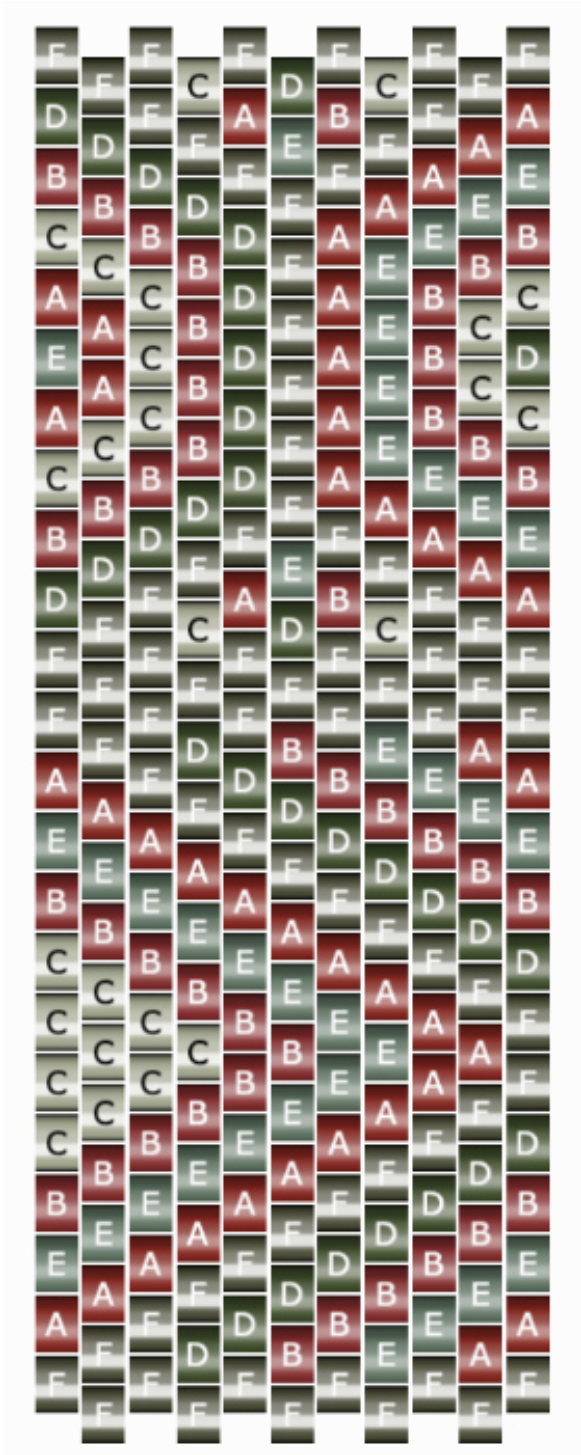
Row 45: ← 11F

Row 46: → 10F

Once you have stitched all 46 rows, zip the tube together and tie off the threads.

Instructions - Peyote Side Flat Tube

Rows 1 and 2: → 3F, 1C, 1F, 1D, 1F, 1C, 3F

Row 3: ← 1A, 1F, 1B, 1A, 1F, 1D

Row 4: → 1D, 1F, 1E, 1F, 1A

Row 5: ← 1E, 1A, 2F, 1D, 1B

Row 6: → 1B, 1D, 1F, 1A, 1E

Row 7: ← 1B, 1E, 1A, 1D, 1B, 1C

Row 8: → 1C, 1B, 1F, 1E, 1B

Row 9: ← 1C, 1B, 1A, 1D, 1C, 1A

Row 10: → 1A, 1B, 1F, 1E, 1C

Row 11: ← 1D, 1B, 1A, 1D, 1C, 1E

Row 12: → 1A, 1B, 1F, 1E, 1C

Row 46: → 5F

Once you have stitched all 46 rows, zip the tube together and tie off the threads.

Repeat to make a second tube.
